We use 100% recycled paper for our Bond, and offset products. For coated paper including Silk and Gloss, we use a paper that is 55% recycled - a fantastic, environmentally friendly alternative when no cost-effective, 100% recycled, coated paper is available today.

Inks

InterPrint (uk) are proud to say we only print with eco-friendly inks, which contain sustainable vegetable oil instead of mineral oil, and do not compromise the quality of our work. Whether you're ordering business cards, flyers or birthday cards, you can be rest assured that your high-quality prints are contributing to the health of our environment.

Our policy ensures that the documentation is appropriate to the nature, scale and environmental impacts of its activities, products and services, and also includes a staff understanding of meeting both the requirements of ISO 14001 and ISO 9001.
